Keith Boocock, CPAB's Chief Executive Officer, passed away on June 18, 2008, after suffering a stroke. Keith was with CPAB almost from our inception, initially as a Vice President, and then as CEO from September 2006. Prior to joining CPAB he was a partner of Deloitte and Touche LLP and its predecessor firm Touche Ross for over 30 years. At Deloitte Keith led the forensic and litigation support functions, specialised in telecommunications and regulated industries, and was the firm's National Director of Risk Management.

As CEO of CPAB, Keith led the transition from the start-up phase into the mature operation we are today. Keith positioned CPAB for further enhancement as an audit regulator going forward. He was also instrumental in CPAB becoming a significant contributor to IFIAR, the International Forum of Independent Audit Regulators. Under Keith's leadership, CPAB further enhanced the international reputation of our work. Keith played a major role in advancing CPAB's mission of promoting high-quality external audits of reporting issuers, to support public confidence in capital markets. We will sorely miss Keith's leadership, professionalism and sense of humour.
